## Academic Advising for Transfer Students

The core classes below are required of *all* undergraduates at the University of Dallas.  
**Department Chairs alone will certify transfer credits into their department for their incoming transfer majors.**

**English                    12 hours required**

6 hours must be taken at UD (almost always Lit Trad I and II); 6 hours can be transferred

The following courses will be considered to transfer for Lit Trad III and IV

- Literature- Dramatic tragedy & comedy courses\*
- Literary- Novel courses

**Philosophy                9 hours required**

Transfer credit is not given for UD's PHI 1301, but transfer courses will be considered for placement out of PHI 2323\* or the upper level philosophy elective

**History                    12 hours required**

The following courses will usually transfer:

- American History, beginning to 1877
- American History, 1877 to present
- Western Civilization I, beginning to Reformation period\*
- Western Civilization II, Reformation to post WWII

**Math/Fine Art            9 hours required**

To fulfill the Math/Art requirement a student may either take 2 Math courses & 1 Fine Art or 2 Fine Art courses & 1 Math but at least one approved math must be taken at UD

The following are appropriate to transfer in as an Art credit

- Art, Music or Theatre History
- History of Art and Architecture\*

The following are appropriate to transfer in as a Math credit

- Calculus
- Euclidean and Non-Euclidean Geometry
- Linear Point Set Theory

Note: UD does not require *or* accept College Algebra, Business or Finite Math

**Economics                3 hours required**

An Economics course in principles of microeconomics will transfer and satisfy the core.

**Science                    7 to 8 hours required (including labs)**

A student must choose one Biological Science and one Physical Science each; both must have a lab and both can be transferred into the University

The following are appropriate to transfer in as a Biological Science credit

- Basic Ideas of Biology
- General Biology
- Environmental Science

The following are appropriate to transfer in as a Physical Science credit

- Astronomy
- General Chemistry
- Basic Ideas of Chemistry
- Basic Ideas of Physics

**Language                    3 – 14 hours required**

6 – 8 hours of Intermediate language course are required

To qualify for the Intermediate level a student must do one of the following

- Take an Elementary level language course
- Test into the Intermediate level course

Languages offered

French	Spanish
German	Greek
Italian	Latin

**Politics                    3 hours required**

The University requires only one course but is specific about its content. Therefore no transfer course satisfies the requirement.

**Theology                    6 hours required**

Because of its unique content it is advised that students who would like to transfer fulfill the theology requirement at the University.

However, occasionally a scripture course will transfer.

Grades of D+ or below do not transfer

### General Transfer Information

**Community College**

- Credits transferred from a community college may not exceed the number of credits a student would earn in the first two years at the University. (Approximately 60 hrs)
- Advanced credits may not be earned at a community college

**Advanced Credits**

- Students must earn 38 advanced hours to graduate, 30 of those hours must be earned at the University of Dallas

All transfer credits are subject to the approval of an Academic Dean of the College.
