Statement for Admitting International Students into the EPP

TEA Rule (19 TAC 230.11(b)) “any applicant for Texas educator certificate must be able to communicate, listen, read, write, and comprehend the English Language sufficiently to use it easily and readily in daily communication and teaching.”

Based on this requirement, a foreign credential evaluator that has been recognized by the State of Texas must evaluate all foreign transcripts. In addition, all student applicants whose native language is not English must submit a score report from the TOEFL. Approved scores as of October 22, 2017 are a minimum of 24 in Speaking, a minimum of 22 in Listening, a minimum of 22 in Reading, and a minimum of 21 in Writing. Scores must be within two years from the date of testing.
