If you would like this information withheld from the public, you must go in person to the Office of the Registrar by the 12th class day in the fall and spring semesters or the 4th class day either summer term and sign a "Request to Prevent Disclosure of Directory Information." Please understand that this information may be provided to UD officials and other specified individuals as prescribed by law. It is also permissible for the University to release information from a student's educational record to a parent, provided the student is a "dependent" as defined in section 152 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.
