#BeCyberSmart - WiFi on Campus

There are two WiFi options on campus: UDAIR-Hotspot and UDAIR-Guest. It is recommended that faculty and staff connect to the UDAIR-Hotspot connection for any academic or business purposes. Your UDAIR-Hotspot WiFi login credentials are your single sign-on/network username and password. Please note, the UDAIR-Guest network has limited bandwidth and session times, and is not intended for work on UD proprietary information.

#BeCyberSmart - Set Up Multi-Factor Authentication

This is a courtesy reminder that if you have not already done so, please set up multi-factor authentication for your Single Sign-On/Network credentials. Multi-factor authentication will provide you with an additional level of security as well as allow you to reset your network password whenever needed.
