Financial Aid: The FAFSA renewal form for 2019-2020 aid was due January 15, 2019 for priority award. If you have not completed your 2018 tax statement, you may use your 2017 tax returns to estimate. Aid in effect on the Irving campus is available for Rome according to the usual stipulations. Aid cannot be applied to the bill for Rome unless all the paperwork is completed. Please contact the Financial Aid Office for further information.

Rome Fee: All students pay a \$795 Rome Fee, which covers the Italian visa fee, Italian public health insurance, Italian permesso tax, book rental, International Student ID Card, Orientation, local transportation in Rome, and express mail of visas. **This fee is due the semester prior to Rome participation and cannot be financed by financial aid.**

Passport Photos: Required by Italian government for various documents. UD Post Office charges 2/\$5.00.

Airfare: The University arranges a group flight. The Rome staff will meet the group flight and provide buses to the campus at the beginning of the semester and buses to the airport at the end for students on the group flight. Own arrangements students must provide their own transportation to campus. \$1500 is estimated fare from hub; other departure cities will vary, fall fares may be higher.

Rome Program Trips Fee: This fee covers the costs of faculty-led trips to such destinations as Assisi, Florence, Venice and Greece. It also covers transportation costs of day trips and museum entrance fees for all the trips (\$2985). This cost will be added to the semester term bill and can be financed by financial aid.

Rome Room/Board: Room (\$3500) and board (\$2880) in Rome costs \$6380. Students who commute while in Irving will see a much larger difference on their Rome term bill versus Irving bill since they do not normally have a room and board charge on their account.

Spending Money: Don't rely on loans for spending money. Loans often don't come in on time. Be sure to enroll in the BankMobile Refund Program. Amount needed fluctuates with the Euro (currently estimated at \$3750). Work hard to save over the summer and at Christmas.

Payment: The Rome fee and the airfare should be prepaid at the Business Office. Tuition payments for the Rome semester should be addressed to: The Business Office, University of Dallas, 1845 E Northgate, Irving, TX, 75062-4736. Checks should be made payable to the University of Dallas. You can also pay term bills online using **CashNet**. If the student is enrolled in the installment plan, payments begin July 5 for fall and December 5 for spring (for 5-payment plan). **All final tuition payment deadlines must be met for Final Clearance for Rome.**

Refunds: Students who withdraw from the Rome Program prior to the deadline specified for each semester may receive a refund of payments made for Rome. Between the withdrawal deadline and the date of departure, students may receive a refund of payments except for the Rome fee, the Visa fee, and any cancellation penalties on travel arrangements. After departure, students are eligible for reimbursement per the University policy for all students for tuition, room and board. There is no reimbursement for travel fees after departure unless and to the extent that the student or University is eligible to receive a refund from third parties in connection with travel expenses (Certain exceptions to this policy may be approved in specific instances such as illness or injury).
