

## Italian Plug Adapters

The typical plug adapter is three-pronged, but there are two versions of that—with big prongs and small ones. Most of what the campus has is the small, three pronged variety. The middle prong is the ground. Dr. Hatlie, the Academic Dean and Director of the Rome Campus, is fairly sure that there is grounding throughout the Rome Campus.



While the above model is acceptable, there is also a big, two pronged plug adapter that may be used. This adapter seems to be safer, and within several decades it will probably be the case that both Italy and the Due Santi Campus will be on this standard.



You may also purchase a grounded USA to Europe plug adapter. This adapter will allow all three USA prongs to fit within your adapter.



If the adapter you bring does not work you will be able to find one at the local supermarket, TOP. They sell adapters of all kinds (e.g. from the big three to the small three, from the small three to the big three and everything in between).
